- Training will consist of 8, quarterly 2-day (Fri, Sat) sessions delivered in-person in Prince George beginning October 2022.
- You must commit to attending all of the dates.
- CME credits and physician reimbursement for lost clinical time will be offered. Staff will work with managers to ensure compensation for their time
- Successful applicants will be informed in mid June 2022

WHAT TO EXPECT

- A comprehensive, two year commitment, focused on practiced-based leadership development designed specifically for healthcare leaders..
- Elements of the curriculum will be co-created with the learning cohort to ensure real-world relevance.
- The first cohort will consist of 30 peer or self nominated members equally divided between physicians and staff.

Participants in this program will engage in a network with other physician and staff leaders to develop the skills and competencies to see, understand, and influence complex challenges. This comprehensive, practice-based program seeks to develop and motivate healthcare providers who aspire to transform the Prince George healthcare system.

PARTICIPANT COMMITMENT AND EXPECTATIONS

As Northern physicians and staff, we recognize and respect how busy you are and how valuable your time is. Leadership development is a commitment; it requires you to take time away from your day-to-day work. However, the benfit that comes from stepping away and reflecting on your work cannot be understated. Reflective practice is paramount to growth and development.

As a member of a select cohort of new and aspiring leaders in Prince George, you will come together for 8 sessions over a two-year period. Each session will be face-to-face and take place over two days. Please note: It is imperative that you commit to all of the dates shown below in order to attend the program.

SCHEDULING AND COMPENSATION

Our colleagues at Interior Health created an advisory group with participants from the education sessions to help plan the next session. Sessions were planned three months at a time. We will create a similar group following our first session in October 2022. Representatives will include cohort members, Facility Engagement, Northern Health (administration and medical leadership), Physician Quality Improvement, and Prince George CME.

The results of the UHNBC Medical Staff Survey were used to plan the sessions outlined here and provide a general roadmap. However, the advisory group will guide the development of the agendas. The following draft has yet to be confirmed with exact times and speakers.

CME credits and physician reimbursement for lost clinical time will be offered. Similarly, staff will work with their managers to schedule time and ensure compensation.
